



## OFFICIAL MS. MARVELOUS PAGEANT RULES

- The contestant must have lived in Indiana for at least three months prior to the pageant date.
- Each contestant must be a U.S. citizen and must be of good moral character; never have been convicted of a crime; have no criminal charges pending against them, or have any adjudication pending against them.
- The Ms. Marvelous Pageant will allow any female to compete no matter if married, single, divorced, widowed or separated.
- Each contestant is required to attend, and be on time, to all practices, meetings, and rehearsals leading up to the date of the event.
- Contestants agree to participate in all events of the pageant. Failure or refusal to participate may result in disqualification. Categories include: interview, casual wear, and evening wear.
- Contestants will conduct themselves with dignity, grace, and good manners to the best of their ability.
- If contestants act unacceptably at any time during the pageant events, they may be disqualified.
- Contestants must agree the decisions of the Ms. Marvelous Judges are final.
- Upon request contestant must produce proof of disability (IEP, 504 Plan, SSI, physician's documentation).
